THE LORD'S PRAYER

A NEW TESTAMENT MODEL FOR DAILY PRAYER

Matt 6:9-13

'Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name.
'Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.
'Give us this day our daily bread.

'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever.

Amen.'

1. OUR FATHER WHO ART IN HEAVEN...

- Always come to God as your heavenly Father
- Throw off the slave mentality and come boldly before Him
- Focus on the blood of Christ as your only right to get into His presence daily (Heb. 10.19-22)

3. THY KINGDOM COME, THY WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN...

- Spend time listening to what the Father's will is
- Pray for the coming of His kingdom [His presence, rule, and power] in the following places on earth
- · Your own life
- Your family & friends
- Your church
- Your city & nation

2....HALLOWED BE THY NAME...

- We enter His gates with thanksgiving in our hearts and we enter His courts with praise
- Begin your time of prayer with praise and thanksgiving
- Focus on thanking Him for all the good He has done
- Worship Him by praising and worshipping each Person of the Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

4. GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD...

- Ask the Lord to meet all of your family needs in the area of finances. Settle it in your heart, that it is His will to prosper you!
- Also, ask Him for the bread of the Word of God for your life.
 The Word of God is the bread for our souls daily.
- Ask for the bread of His presence to be with you today.



5. FORGIVE US OUR DEBTS, AS WE ALSO HAVE FORGIVEN OUR DEBTORS

- We must daily go the Lord and find forgiveness for our sins. We can find forgiveness based upon 1 John 1.9
- "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us of our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
- We must also daily search our hearts for unforgiveness towards others, and we must forgive them from our hearts through prayer.
- Determine to walk in absolute forgiveness today!

7. FOR THINE IS THE KINGDOM, THE POWER, AND THE GLORY FOREVER.

- As we conclude in prayer, declare that it is all about His kingdom and not ours
- Acknowledge that it is all through His power and not ours
- Proclaim that He should receive all of the glory and not us

6. AND DO NOT LEAD US INTO TEMPTATION, BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL

- We should daily ask the Lord Jesus for His protection from the attacks of the enemy through temptation
- We must also ask for daily deliverance from areas of evil already set up in our lives. Areas of - thought, lust, pride, unbelief, etc.. until they are absolutely gone!

8 AMFN

- Amen is not our telling God goodbye
- Amen is a statement of faith that literally means now, let it be so what I have prayed before You.


2. Prayers for God's love to grow:


